AGM

2021 Formula Classic Championship representative body and format

At the February 2021 MSA State Executive meeting FCR was confirmed as the sole representative body for Historic, Libre and Racing Sports Cars within the State of WA. This resolution by the State Executive has brought to conclusion the conflict and confusion that has marred Formula Classic racing in recent years. The hard work by FCR committee members Marty Bullock, Allan Ould and Craig Thompson needs to be acknowledged in securing this outcome for our group.

The championship format for the 2021 Formula Classic season will be as follows. Within Formula Classic there will be two sub categories; Historic cars that fully comply with their HTP / COD papers and Libre cars. All the cars will race as one field, as has happened in previous years however there will be two championships, with their own points and trophies, within Formula Classic. The FCR Handicap championship will run as normal across the whole grid irrespective of which class the car is racing in.
